## Overview


The **Export HTML** feature is available in two locations within the platform. When triggered, your browser will immediately download the HTML file for the selected design. A green toast notification will confirm the successful export with the message: "Successfully exported HTML".

## Exporting HTML from the Email Designer

You can export the HTML of a design while actively viewing or editing it within the email designer.

1. Open the desired email design in the **Email Designer**.
2. Click the **Actions** menu at the top of the editor.
3. Select **Export HTML** from the dropdown menu.
4. The HTML file will automatically download to your browser's default download location.
5. A green toast message will appear confirming: "Successfully exported HTML".



## Exporting HTML from the All Designs Page

You can also export the HTML of any design directly from the **All Designs** (Design Library) listing page without opening the design first.

1. Navigate to **All Designs** from the main navigation.
2. Locate the design you would like to export.
3. Hover over or select the design to reveal the **three-dot (ellipsis) menu**.
4. Click the **three-dot menu** and select **Export HTML**.
5. The HTML file will automatically download to your browser's default download location.
6. A green toast message will appear confirming: "**Successfully exported HTML**".



## Frequently Asked Questions

### Can I export HTML for any design in my library?

- Yes. The **Export HTML** option is available for any design accessible to you in the **Email Designer** or on the **All Designs** page.

### Where is the file saved?

- The file downloads to your browser's default download folder, just like any other file download.

### Do I need any special permissions to use this feature?

- No additional permissions are required beyond standard access to the **Email Platform**.
